


SUBJECT	MODAL	PREDICATE	DEGREE	EXPLANATION
You	must	be quiet.	Order 	You have to. There is no choice.
He	mustn't (must not)	come.	Prohibition 	You are not allowed.
She	can/may	go.	Permission 	She has the green light.
It	can't (cannot)/ may not	go.	No permission 	The light is red.
We	will	do it.	Decision 	We want to do it.
You	won't (will not)	do it.	Refusal 	We don't want to do it.
They	should	stay at home.	Advice 	I think it is good for them.
I	shouldn't/should not	be lazy.	Duty 	I have to work.
May/ Might/Can/Could		I go there?	Request 	I am asking for permission.
