INTERROGATIVE PRONOUNS

WHO?

- Asks questions about people (subject)

WHOM?

- Asks questions about people (object)

WHICH?

- Asks questions about animals and objects

WHOSE?

- Asks questions about possession

WHERE?

- Asks questions about places

WHEN?

- Asks questions about time

WHY?

- Asks questions about reason

WHAT?

- Asks questions about things

HOW?

- Asks questions about manner

WHO? (PERSON)

- Who are you?

WHOM? (PERSON)

- Whom are you travelling with?

WHICH? (OBJECT)

- Which one is your bag?

WHOSE? (POSSESSION)

- Whose son are you?

WHERE? (PLACE)

- Where are you going?

WHEN? (TIME)

- When did you leave your home?

WHY? (REASON)

- Why did you leave your home?

WHAT? (THINGS)

- What do you want to do abroad?

HOW? (MANNER)

- How are you going there?

WHO? (PERSON)

- John.

WHOM? (PERSON)

- Some people I met on the way.

WHICH? (OBJECT)

- The grey one.

WHOSE? (POSSESSION)

- I'm Mr. Moyo's son./ I am the son of Mr. Moyo.

WHERE? (PLACE)

- I'm going overseas.

WHEN? (TIME)

- I left four months ago.

WHY? (REASON)

- There were no opportunities for me there.

WHAT? (THINGS)

- I want to find a good job.

HOW? (MANNER)

- I don't know yet. I'll figure it out...
