### **Describe Animals in the Jungle: Examples**

- I have never seen a *jaguar* in real life but I've seen the car version of course!
- <u>Giant pandas</u> make me think of the film 'Kung Fu Panda'.
- I think that *lemurs* are funny. I'd love to see one in real life.
- My brother loves <u>chameleons</u> because they can change colours very quickly. I also find them fascinating.
- People think that <u>*sloths*</u> are lazy because they move slowly all the time.
- I am afraid of snakes and I wouldn't want to meet a *boa constrictor* or an *anaconda* in the jungle.
- Tigers are *beautiful* but we should be scared of them all the same.



We can also use the above **Adjectives** to describe animals in the jungle.

Let's look at a few examples:

- I really love giant pandas. I think that they are very <u>cute</u>.
- Tigers are *carnivorous* animals. They only feed on other animals.
- Chameleons are <u>smart</u> animals. They can change colours according to their environment.
- Other jungle animals must be very afraid of the boa constrictor. it is a very *powerful* predator.
- Jungle animals such as jaguars are *intimidating*.
- I think that chimpanzees are naturally *good-natured*.
- Sloths are thought to be very <u>lazy</u> considering their behaviour.
- The okapi looks like a zebra because it is *striped*.
- Black panthers are <u>incredible</u> because they actually refer to wild cats with black fur such as leopards or jaguars.
